Policy

The curricula of the schools in the Washington Northeast School District shall be coordinated to allow students to meet or exceed standards established by the Vermont Frameworks and its successor and the school district. Curriculum plans shall be coordinated between sending and receiving schools within the school district and will be periodically reviewed to determine compatibility with schools outside the school district that are attended by substantial numbers of students residing within the school district.

The superintendent or designee shall be responsible for the development, coordination, and evaluation the curriculum. The superintendent shall ensure that the curriculum is consistent with the school district mission as approved by the school board.

The superintendent or designee shall conduct systematic evaluations of all programs within the curriculum and report the results to the school board at least annually.
